



Søly Speedrace - Formula 18

Sailing instructions

Søly Speedrace is a Time Race open for all participants after the last race in F18 Nordic Championship on Saturday September 10, 2011. The objective of the race is to sail from start to finish as quickly as possible. The race course will be laid out southeast of Søly molo.

The Start

The starting line will be between a staff boat and a yellow mark. A green flag indicates that the race course is open. Boats are to sail the track individually and start at will. Once a boat crosses the starting line, the green flag is dropped and the timer started. The race is open for participation for 90 minutes after the first start.

The Finish

The finishing line will be between two yellow marks. Boats sail a free course from start to finish. At the crossing of the finish line a blue checkered flag (signal flag N) is dropped and the timer stopped.

The Timing

The fastest race time will be displayed on a board in the starting vessel. The boat obtaining the quickest time standing wins the race. Boats may run multiple trials as long as the track is open.

The Rules

Gentlemen's rules apply. Non-participating boats are to stay out of the race track. At the start, priority is given to boats on their first run.
